My final golden advice to you is "never think that 'wasta' can make you achieve anything, it is only you and your hard work and persistence that makes you." I know this fact fairly well that Major General Dr. Salman Al-Khalifa did not achieve his consultancy and his post through his family name. **No, it was through his hard work.**
