Anti-Drugs Abuse Day

The United Nations Office on drug and crime (UNODC) organized a seminar on drug abuse at Sheikh Ibrahim Mosque. This year theme is" let's talk about drugs". As a continuity of the activity a drug exhibition was held at Jawad Food Garden in collaboration with the Ministry of Interior, this activity aims at helping people recognizing the different types of drugs.

Workshop on AIDS Awareness

A workshop on AIDS awareness was organized by the Unicef Regional Office for Middle East and North Africa, the executive board of the GCC health ministers' council and UNAIDS in collaboration with the ministry of health. Presentations on the challenges facing national health systems in tackling AIDS were made by delegates from Bahrain, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, the UAE and Yemen.

Legislation of Pre-Marital test

His Majesty the King, Hamad Bin Isa Al Khalifa, issued law N.11 on the 22nd, June, 2004, on premarital examination for both genders. The law states that the Ministry of Health will coordinate with any other related body on placing regulations and directives to provide medical examination. The law also states that any citizen about to get married even if the spouse is non-Bahraini must undergo a pre-marital examination according to the regulations and procedure issued by the Ministry of Health.

Combating Chronic Non-Communicable Diseases

The Ministry of Health has organized the fourth workshop for governmental and non-governmental representatives to outlay a national plan for fighting Chronic Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs). The workshop was held at the Ministry of Health on the 12th of June 2004. Four teams outlined their tasks about the proposal of adapting a national program. The first two teams will be directing their efforts in the fields of promoting sports and proper nutrition, while the other two teams will focus on combating smoking and developing proper stress management strategies.

Nursing and disaster preparedness

On the 29th of June 2004, around 170 people, including representatives from 45 Middle East countries, attended the sixth meeting of the regional advisory panel on Disaster Nursing preparedness, Response and Recovery in the Eastern Mediterranean Region. Present at the opening of conference were Princess Mona Al Hussein of Jordon who is WHO patron of Nursing and Midwifery for Eastern Mediterranean Region (EMRO), the Minister of Health, Nada Haffadh, the Regional Director for WHO-EMRO, Dr Hussain Al Ghezairy and the Regional Advisor for Nursing

and Allied Health for WHO-EMRO, Dr Fariba Al Durazi. The conference focused on the vital role of nurses in handling natural and man-made disasters and the strategies needed to face such crises.
