Authorship credit should be based only on substantial contributions to:

- (1) Conception and design or analysis and interpretation of data
- (2) Drafting the article or revising it critically for important intellectual content
- (3) Final approval of the version to be published

Conditions 1, 2 and 3 must all be met. Participation solely in the acquisition of funding or the collection of data does not justify authorship. General supervision of the research group is not sufficient for authorship. Being the radiologist or pathologist who participated in diagnosing the case does not justify authorship, except if 1, 2, and 3 are met.

Authors should be prepared to explain to the chief editor the order in which authors are listed.

Original research studies are expected to have had approval of their study by the research and ethical committee or the Institutional Review Board (IRB) of the hospital concerned. Informed consent should be taken whenever it is necessary. Randomized controlled study should be registered whenever possible.
