#### Aids Awareness in Bahrain Women Society

As part of celebrating International Women's Day, Bahrain Women Society conducted a seminar on AIDS awareness by Dr. Somaiya A Jowder. The topics she covered were the stigmata attached to the disease, ways of transmission, facilities available in Bahrain for affected patients and the management of HIV infection.

#### **King Hamad Hospital Design starts**

Australian Hospital design group has started the initial designs of King Hamad Hospital in Muharraq. The design is focusing on health services for women and children, in addition to the provision of educational facilities that will be used by the Royal College of Surgeon in Ireland.

#### A New Medical University in Bahrain

A new Medical University will be built in Bahrain next to the upcoming general hospital in Muharraq and will serve as its main teaching facility. Professor Kevin O'Malley is to take over soon as the President of the Medical University of Bahrain (MUB). The college will initially admit 40-50 students from Bahrain and other countries. The college will run a six-year medical degree program, and will be expanded to cover the areas of pharmacy, nursing and dentistry. MUB is to be formally launched on May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2004.

#### **New Clinical Guidelines for Primary Health Care**

The Ministry of Health formulated new clinical guidelines for more effective delivery of primary care in Bahrain. The priority areas for enforcement were Breast Cancer, Diabetes, Obesity, Periodontal Disease and Myocardial Infarction. This comes as part of a quality-improvement program in the country and it aims at getting quality in cost-effective manner, in addition to getting International Standardization Organization (ISO) qualifications.

#### Women's Health Day celebrated in Health Centers

Two Bahraini Health centers celebrated Women's Health Day on the 27<sup>th</sup>, March, 2004. The events took place at Shaikh Sabah Al Salem Health Center in Umm Al Hassam and A'ali Health Center. Hundreds of women attended both events at which they were given health awareness tips and free check up for blood pressure, blood sugar and other conditions.

#### Plans for health insurance policy for expatriates

The Ministry of Health is looking at methods and systems adopted in Ireland and France in order to implement a comprehensive health-insurance policy for expatriates. A detailed report on the most suitable system for Bahrain would be

presented to the Minister of Health and other members of the ministerial council responsible for implementing the health- insurance scheme.
