A Journey through Internship





A memorandum of understanding was signed between King Hamad University Hospital and King Saud Bin Abdulaziz University for Health Sciences on 25 June 2014 for the establishment of Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS) program.

Dr. Saud Alturki from King Saud Bin Abdulaziz University for Health Sciences visited King Hamad University Hospital to discuss the insufficient ATLS courses in Bahrain. KHUH staff are unable to be trained in ATLS/ATCN/PHTLS and the instructors of these courses would lose their instructor status due to not being able to instruct the required number of courses. ATLS, at both Instructor and Provider levels, is designed to improve the ability of primary care physicians to assess patterns of severe trauma and to institute measures to save life and prevent further injury. KHUH being a disaster center for the Bahrain International Airport, Shaikh Khalifa Port and main highways, leads to a higher demand for ATLS providers and instructors.
