CASE 1

- Answer 1. Frontal mucocele.
- **Answer 2.** Occipito frontal, lateral radiography and CAT.
- Answer 3. Excision through osteoplastic flap.

CASE 2

- Answer 1. Facial paralysis on the left side.
- Answer 2. Exposure Keratitis.
- **Answer 3.** Carcinoma of the parotid involving the facial nerve.
- Answer 4. Pure Tone Audiometry, Speech Audiometry, Impedance Audiometry, Shirmer's Test, Electrogustometry, Facial Nerve Excitability, Strength-duration Curve, Electroneurography, Electromyography, Sialogram and CAT.

Answer 5. Excision of the left parotid with the facial nerve followed by nerve grafting and radiotherapy.
